Soft cheesemaking & dairy products 101

Learn how to milk your own dairy goat and then make Chevre, Mozzarella, Ricotta, Feta, Yogurt, and more! Easy dairy products to make at home with no special equipment! This class will offer an introduction to the concepts involved in cheese making as well as the practical applications. We will cover topics such as making your own cultures, tools of the trade, etc.

All materials are provided, \$50/student. Maximum class size: 10 students.

Classes are the first Saturday of every month (excluding Nov., Dec, and Jan). Beginning at 8am ending at noon.

Hard cheesemaking 102

Press your own hard cheeses! Class offers an introduction to the concepts involved in hard cheesemaking. Follow the process from start to finish on Gouda, as well as variations that are easy to adapt to a variety of rinds, wraps, and washes. Pressing and aging techniques for the home cheesemaker are discussed.

All materials are provided, \$50/student. Maximum class size: 10 students. Classes are by apt.

Milk Maid Training

More than you ever wanted to know about dairy goats. Learn the in and outs of raising your own dairy goats. We cover milking techniques for a variety of breeds (miniature and full size goats), training, feed, housing, breeding, and general care. Bring old closed-toed shoes. Class begins at 1pm ending after a few hours. *All materials are provided, \$30/student. Maximum class size: 10 students. Due to increased demand, milkmaid classes are held the same day as Dairy Day.*
